	16:00		Visit the <b>Iwami Ginzan World Heritage Centre</b> At the Iwami Ginzan World Heritage Centre, visitors can learn about the Iwami Ginzan Silver Mine, which produced one third of the world's silver around 400 years ago, with an overview and history of the mine, and watch VR videos of the tunnels.
	18:00		Arrive at <b>Iwami Winery Hotel Misato</b> Located in a quiet area along the Gono River, this hotel, which was completely reopened in 2021, offers comfortable rooms and authentic Italian food and wine.
